

# Wild Rivers Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes

September 27, 2022

1. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by President Lori Friberg. Lori welcomed new members/visitors, and all members introduced themselves.
2. Cindy Nault made a motion to approve the August meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Darcy Brown, and the motion passed.
3. Lori reported that non-members participating in workshops will pay a \$10 fee in addition to the regular workshop fee.
4. Lori reported a temporary policy, which is that any guild expenditures of \$500 or greater requires approval by guild vote.
5. Treasurer Cheryl Stromberg provided an overview of the guild's budget. The budget prioritizes, in order, programs, audio visual equipment and becoming a not-for-profit organization.
6. Lori put out a request for volunteers to organize a spring quilter/crafter sale (2-4 volunteers) and a fall quilt show team (5 volunteers). Guild members who are interested in volunteering for these events should contact members of the leadership team.
7. Guild members expressed interest in the addition of a December Open Sew.
8. Show and Tell: Guild members shared beautiful fall-themed projects, including the Bats and Boos quilts made during the recent Facebook group sew along.
9. Tip and Techniques: Melanie Roath gave a demonstration of the disappearing 9 patch. She also read two lovely children's stories: The Little Ghost Who Was a Quilt by Riel Nason, and The Secret Life of a Quilt by Melanie Roath.
10. The meeting was adjourned at about 7:15 pm
