**Cheryl's notes on two cameras:**

I requested a demonstration of the camera with an Android system and spoke with the representative. He indicated that the camera we chose would probably not meet our needs. But, he pointed us to one that they make that has a better camera. It is similar to the one we chose and not much different in price. He did say that the Android system was older on all models and would not be good for web streaming videos.

So, we should use a separate laptop/phone/tablet regardless for any videos we may want to show. This is a heavier model (around 4LBs). It also does not fold up as small as some others. It does articulate more, which I think would be helpful in demonstrations. He said the camera would be able to handle the fast motion of a sewing machine at 30fps, 1080p resolution.

He indicated that it would not be able to be used easily as a video cam, since it would need to be set way back in the room to be able to get the whole altar into the picture. He said this camera is used for medical purposes and can go to an almost microscopic level when zoomed in. It has WIFI, HDMI, mic, VGA and USB. It has miracast, which can be used to connect to the TV, but it may require an additional dongle to support this. I have to look closer at the TV to verify if that extra dongle would be needed. The representative would be available to do a demonstration at a Team meeting. But, I told him I had to pass it by others to see if we wanted to firm this up.

The camera below looks more portable, but only has a USB connection. I think this camera would be harder to work, because it requires special software on a laptop and uses the laptop smarts to connect to the TV. But, it has a better FPS (60 frames per second, speed).
